### **Heritage Arc**

Following the traditional paths of Santa Coloma and La Margineda, you will see some of the oldest and most distinctive monuments in the country. From Romanesque churches to archaeological sites to medieval bridges, you will learn plenty, not just about Andorran history, but Pyrenean history too.



### **Lunch in the Historic Centre**

You will find all sorts of restaurants in the oldest part of the city. The wide range of cuisine on offer will satisfy all palates and budgets.



## Rec del Solà Path - The Green Ring

Enjoy a pleasant stroll amid nature with outstanding views over the city, just a stone's throw from the centre of Andorra la Vella. This linear, flat walk of about 4km (there and back) passes along a little irrigation canal, which was built in 1880 and used to irrigate the orchards.

If you want to learn more about what you see on this walk, do not miss the Green Ring information trails. They will show you the evolution of the agricultural and urban landscapes and how human beings have adapted their way of life to deal with natural risks.



#### Dinner in the city centre

Enjoy the local cuisine on offer around the Avinguda de Meritxell, Fener Boulevard and Riberaygua i Travesseres neighbourhoods.
