DAY 1



Heritage Arc

Following the traditional paths of Santa Coloma and La Margineda, you will see some of the oldest and most distinctive monuments in the country. From Romanesque churches to archaeological sites to medieval bridges, you will learn plenty, not just about Andorran history, but Pyrenean history too.



Rec del Solà Path - The Green Ring

Enjoy a pleasant stroll amid nature with outstanding views over the city, just a stone's throw from the centre of Andorra la Vella.

If you want to learn more about what you see on this walk, do not miss the Green Ring information trails. They will show you the evolution of the agricultural and urban landscapes and how human beings have adapted their way of life to deal with natural risks.

Madriu - Perafita - Claror Valley

Enter the Palomera woods on the shaded slope of Andorra la Vella and discover the magnificent Pyrenean spring colours, as you follow a mountain valley trail declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
