DAY 1



Rec del Solà Path - The Green Ring

Enjoy a pleasant stroll amid nature with outstanding views over the city, just a stone's throw from the centre of Andorra la Vella.

If you want to learn more about what you see on this walk, do not miss the Green Ring information trails. They will show you the evolution of the agricultural and urban landscapes and how human beings have adapted their way of life to deal with natural risks.

Activities in Grandvalira and Vallnord

Visit to Roques al Carrer and World Champions by 99 museums

Stroll around the streets of Andorra la Vella and enjoy the Roques al Carrer ("Rocks in the street") museum, an open-air self-guided tour route where you will observe the great geological diversity of the buildings around you.

Afterwards, enter the world of motors at the World Champions by 99 museum. Thanks to Jorge Lorenzo, the MotoGP driver, experience the thrill of driving a MotoGP motorbike or Formula 1 car, and discover a great collection of unique pieces.



Casa de la Vall and "7 Poetes"

Wonderful lighting makes the "7 Poetes" sculpture by Jaume Plensa and the Casa de la Vall an unmissable night-time tour!
